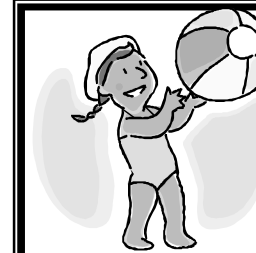

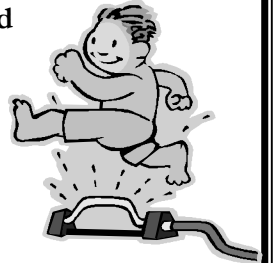
CE COMMITTEE MEETING on Monday, September 13 at 6:30 pm in the Youth Lounge.
